

Calontir will, ON A TRIAL BASIS, accept device and badge submissions on forms that are created and colored using a color printer, or copied on a color copier. This trial will last for approximately 6 months, although if sufficient problems arise the trial may be ended earlier. Expect a decision about the results of this trial sometime in early spring of 2014.

The color values on the device and badge forms produced electronically MUST match the colors produced by hand-coloring with Crayola "Classic" markers. For example, if a device has purple in it, and the color on your computer monitor looks purple, but it comes out of your printer looking lavender or maroon, then that form WILL NOT be accepted by the Saker office.

If you hand-color 1 form and then make color copies of it, the color values on the copies must be true to the original, or else Saker will not process it, but will return it.

You must still send paper copies of device and badge forms to Saker. Submission forms must still be neat and the artwork must be identifiable. The number of copies required for a submission isn't changing. You must still send 1 uncolored and 3 colored copies of the forms. The only change is that these copies may be produced on a color printer or color copier.

The black-and-white, or uncolored, form must be "not colored". A black-and-white copy of a colored form will NOT be accepted.

Saker will still NOT accept forms colored with crayons, colored pencil, or paint.

Saker WILL still accept hand colored forms made using Crayola "Classic" markers or their equivalent. (Rose Art makes good markers, although they are more expensive than Crayola.)

Varying levels of technology are available to heralds and heraldic clients. If you don't have the skills or tools available, you may still need to literally cut out the design and paste it onto the form. As always, please be neat about it, and don't leave obvious extra lines after making copies, and don't let tape marks show.
