

You will work with Kingdom Youth Officers, engaging with them regularly, holding meetings via video conference at least once a quarter or more as desired/required. You are passionate about the development of high quality, fun and educational youth programs and providing safe opportunities for engagement in the Society for children, youth, and families. Working as a Deputy to the Society Seneschal, you will develop resources and assist kingdoms to develop fit-for-purpose youth programs that are compliant with the Society's youth policies and local jurisdictions' requirements. The purpose of this office is to promote and encourage youth and family friendly activities within the SCA. We want our younger members to feel safe and to be involved in as many different aspects of the SCA as possible.

The successful candidate should have:

Experience in and enthusiasm for developing and delivering recreational activities with young people

Experience as an SCA youth officer at some level (strongly recommended but not required)

Knowledge and understanding of child/youth learning and development

A current SCA background check (or obtain one before assuming the role)

Check your bowstrings and arrows, and join Us at King's Company of Archers! This event is one of the most enjoyable days of shooting, and We are looking forward to it.



As we near my favourite time of year, we are also entering one of the busiest months of this year's calendar. Calontir has adopted the SCA's COVIDSafe policy, meaning that anyone attending events within our borders must show proof of vaccination, or a negative COVID test, to enter. The efficacy of the vaccines continue to be proven, and they are readily available, at no cost, in all the states which make up Calontir for people 5 years of age and over. Vaccinations have been approved for children under the age of 5, but availability is more restricted.



EVENT FLYER GUIDELINES

For Their Majesties to hold Court, or any official business to occur, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event.

Before sending an event flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: https://www.calontir.org/events/ For information on how to submit a flyer please visit: https://www.calontir.org/chronicler/

For an event to be considered complete and published, so official Kingdom business can be carried out, an event announcement MUST contain these **SIX ITEMS**:

- Dates of the event- day and month
- Event time: when site opens & closes to the populace
- Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

 Details of Registration : Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

Example of wording for Registration:

Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 / Children 5 & Under: FREE

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. If you wish to send a PDF, you are more than welcomed. However, I need a version I am able to edit, because sometimes that PDF just will not convert correctly and I would like to keep your flyers looking nice.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1**st **of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event**. (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
