Cian's Lemon Curd

Basic Recipe (it doubles well)

- * 1 Cup of sugar (I have been using raw sugar for most things, it works and adds a bit of depth of flavor other than just sweet but do not use brown sugar)
- * 1 big pinch of salt
- * 5 Lemons (both juice and zest)
- * ~1/3 to 1/2 Cup of juice needed, if less than 1/3 add water to get to at least that)
- * 6 egg yolks
- * 4 oz of good, sweet butter, cold, cubed up.

You will need:

- * A whisk
- * metal bowl (stainless works best for this due to the acid in lemons)
- * a pot to boil water that the bowl will fit on top of (or a double boiler if you have one)
- * Metal screen strainer to filter the lemon juice (no seeds)
- * Measuring cups for sugar and juice

Put water on to boil, usually only need an inch or two in the pan for this.

Measure sugar and salt and put in bowl. Zest the lemons on top of the sugar/salt mixture into the bowl.

Squeeze lemons through strainer into a measuring cup. Add egg yolks directly to the salt/sugar mixture.

Add the juice, mix into a slurry, and put on double boiler.

Stir with whisk for 10 to 15 minutes until everything is incorporated and it starts to thicken and turn very, very yellow. When it thickens a bit and covers the back of a spoon it should be ready

Take off heat and incorporate butter with the whisk, when all is incorporated, and it is smooth place in a clean jar(s) and put it refrigerator to cool and set.

What a great Lilies that was! So much fun that I wanna go back.

Well, I can't go back, but I *can* go to Pennsic. To quote Drix, it's gonna be one L of a time. I look forward to seeing a host of Calontiri there.

Now, let's get to business. At Lilies, I announced that Mellitus will become the new Kingdom Historian and that Ma'az will be the new Lanner Herald. I'm excited to see them fulfill the cool ideas they have for each role.

Side note: I had great options with both offices, with both Sofya la Rus and Padraigin also applying for Lanner. It wasn't an easy decision, but thanks to both of them for stepping forward to volunteer, even if the choice didn't go their way.

That leaves us with three pre-existing openings, Blue Hawk plus deputy, and Saker. If you're interested in any of these jobs, please email me at goldfalcon@calontir.org by the end of Pennsic.

And we have a new opening. Sofya has asked to step down as Habicht Herald. She's done a fantastic job in this position, and I'm going to have a heck of a time replacing her. If you're interested, email me at the same address by the 1st of September.

By the way, the Habicht is in charge of heraldic education, teaching members of the College of Heralds and coordinating with RUSH for heraldic classes.

Speaking of education, let's talk about a single device this month, that of Cariadoc of the Bow. It is: Argent, a griffin segreant Azure, drawing a bow Vert, in chief an increscent Or, fimbriated Sable. By the way, this was registered in January of 1973, so happy 50th anniversary to this device!

Anyway, you know the background is white, or Argent. Easy peasy.

Then there's a griffin Azure, or blue. If you were paying attention last month (and of course you were), you recognize segreant as the griffin's attitude. This is an odd attitude, as it only applies to griffins and dragons, and is similar to rampant. As you can see, it's the beast on both feet with paws extended.

Next comes the bow, which is Vert, or green. Nothing difficult here, although I will say if I see a griffin shooting

at me with a bow, I won't really care if the bow is green, gray, or grmphac, the royal color of small furry creatures from Alpha Centauri.

So we move on to the item in chief. In chief, as you probably already know, means it's at the top of the device. The item here is an increscent, which means a crescent with the horns facing the observer's left. Cariadoc has an Islamic persona, by the way, and the crescent is a nice touch for that.

Finally, we get to the part where it says it's fimbriated Sable. These are the black lines in the crescent.

Interesting, eh?

Well, it's more interesting if you know the story of how Pennsic came to be. In AS III, Cariadoc won the first crown tourney of the Midrealm. He won again in AS V (third crown of the Midrealm). In one of these reigns (I'm not sure which), he sent a letter declaring war on the East Kingdom.

The East Kingdom gave that letter the attention they thought it deserved. In other words, they ignored it.

Then, in AS VI, Cariadoc, having moved, won the 8th crown tourney of the East Kingdom. This gave him access to all the kingdom regalia. Among this regalia was a letter from the King of the Midrealm declaring war...

Cariadoc did the only sensible thing. He accepted the challenge sent by himself, and declared war on the Midrealm.

And lo, did the two realms muster their armies and march forth to battle! This was Pennsic I, and in that war did Cariadoc and the Eastern Tiger fight valiantly but were overcome by the forces of the Dragon.

Making Cariadoc the only person in history to declare war on himself... and lose.

The **Palio di Siena** is a street fair held in the public plaza in Siena, Italy, since the Middle Ages. It continues to this day. We aim to recreate the atmosphere of a street fair with food vendors, shops, games, both rattan and steel fighting, archery, thrown weapons and the central theme of the Palio to this day; equestrian activities!!

The Palio is a competition between the local *contrade* (neighborhoods). Everyone attending will select a *contrade*, and at the end of the day, the members of the winning *contrade* will receive a prize. You are not required to stick with your team. Just enjoy the day, and tokens will be awarded for your participation (more for winning things!) The team that collects the most tokens wins!

We are excited to have **merchants!** There will be no merchant fee. No merchant is too small; bring a blanket or table. No inventory is too small; bring a single item to sell or hundreds!

Would you like to cook and sell a food item? We'd love to have from all across the Known World! Cooked on site or made ahead and packaged safely. We have a kitchen on site, but if you want to use it, we'll need to know well in advance, so we can schedule kitchen times.

There will be no feast. Information about food vendors will be published closer to the event. Plan accordingly.

There is ample camp space on site. Potable water, showers, and some flush toilets are available. Portable toilets will also be located near camping and activities.

FLYER GUIDELINES

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: <https://www.calontir.org/events/> For information on how to submit a flyer please visit: <https://www.calontir.org/chronicler/>

Flyers **MUST** contain these **SIX** ITEMS:

- ◆ Day month and year of the event
- ◆ Site open & close times for populace
- ◆ Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- ◆ Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- ◆ Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

- ◆ Details of Registration : Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

**Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member
Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 /
Children 5 & Under: FREE**

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1st of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event.** (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
